Core Needle Biopsy Procedure:

Findings:

Bulky right cervical lymphadenopathy

Details:

After full discussion of risks (bleeding, infection, damage to adjacent structures, insufficient sample requiring need for core needle biopsy or other type of biopsy) and benefits of core needle biopsy were discussed, and CT images reviewed with patient, the patient verbally consented for the procedure. 3 milliliters of 1% lidocaine with 1:100,000 epinephrine and bicarbonate buffer was infiltrated in skin over right level 2 mass and in the mass itself. This needle and then an 18 gauge were used to aspirate along the tract of the planned biopsy and there was no aspiration of blood. The area was prepped with betadine. A 2mm incision was made in the skin. An 18gauge core needle biopsy with 11mm penetration depth was used to take 6 biopsies which were placed on telfa using sterile technique. The specimen was placed in standard pathology bottle.
