69:05	Q. Do you recall what model of the ECT device-- do you		
69:06	recall what model of an ECT device you were first		
69:07	introduced to?		
69:08	A. Yes. It was a custom device made by the biomedical		
69:09	engineers at the University of Iowa Hospitals.		
69:10	That was in 1974-- 1975, excuse me. 1975.		
69:11	It was a sine wave device.		
69:12	Q. What do you mean by "custom device"?		
69:13	A. I mean that it was literally put together by the		
69:14	engineers-- it was designed and put together by the		
69:15	engineers employed by the University of Iowa Hospitals.
